Stacking blocks-concepts of balance, hand/eye coordination, problem solving

Sorting and counting objects, puzzles-spatial awareness, visual discrimination; mathematical reasoning and logic

Circle/Storytime-vocabulary, language, and comprehension skills; concepts of print, and phonological awareness
